



DMC Coordinator

The DMC Coordinator is responsible for leading community coalitions across Missouri in their efforts to identify and implement methods and strategies to reduce DMC at both the local and statewide level through coordination of trainings and presentations on racial equity and inclusion; direct collaboration with the DMC Research Analyst; development and maintenance of the agency's DMC Work Plan and day-to-day management of the activities related to the goals and objectives of the DMC Work Plan.

Qualifications: Qualified applicants will possess strong interpersonal, oral and written communication skills; be able to work independently, prioritize work, multitask and have strong organizational skills; and have exceptional abilities in identifying, educating, coordinating, mobilizing diverse groups of stakeholders. A Bachelor's degree in a human services or behavioral sciences-related field with minimum 5 years of experience with the juvenile justice system is preferred, or a master's degree with minimum 3 years of experience with the juvenile justice system. Technical qualifications include use of Microsoft Office Products, presentation equipment, familiarity with social media and time accounting. Travel is required, both overnight in-state and out-of-state.
