Definition of Work:

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to walk, sit, talk, and hear. The employee is routinely required to work with the hand or hands in handling, seizing, holding, or grasping motions and with the fingers in picking or pinching actions; frequently required to lift and/or move up to 30 pounds; occasionally required to exert up to 50 pounds of

force; and is occasionally required to maintain body equilibrium while bending at the waist or at the knees. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and distance vision.

Work Environment

Potential problems may exist with juveniles who do not follow the rules and are subject to sanctions. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.
