

**POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**  
**Supervisor – Court Services**  
**11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, Family Court – Juvenile Division**

**Starting Salary: \$57,734 (Pay Grade 13)** This is a full-time position which includes a full range of benefits including Paid Time Off, Extended Medical Leave, holidays, employee health, dental, life, disability and tuition assistance programs.

**Purpose of Position:** The Supervisor – Court Services position supervises the Court Services Unit of the Juvenile Division of the Family Court. The position supervises and directs the activities of the Deputy Juvenile Officers assigned to the unit and is ultimately responsible for all work performed by the personnel under immediate direction. This position works under the direction of the Juvenile Officer/Family Court Administrator.

**Requirements:** Requires a Master's Degree in sociology or Social Work, Psychology, or Criminal Justice OR a related field. Requires a minimum of five years' experience in the juvenile justice field, preferably from a professional position within the courts. Supervisory experience desired. Requires thorough knowledge of the following: Missouri statutes, in particular, the Juvenile and Criminal Codes, Supreme Court Rules of Practice and Procedure for the Juvenile Court and local Court policies and procedures; current trends and philosophies in the area of Juvenile Justice, including JDAI and evidence-based practice; community resources; state agencies such as MO CD, MO DYS and MO DMH; the state's automated tracking system (JIS) and principles of management and supervision.

**The Supervisor – Court Services must reside in St. Charles County continuously throughout employment with the Juvenile Division.**

Candidate must also have average computer skills in data entry, word processing and modification of standardized forms as necessary. Excellent written and oral communication skills. Must have and maintain a valid Driver's license and satisfactory driving record. Must meet the minimum age requirement of 21 years.
