

Job Announcement Law Enforcement Project Coordinator

Project: Protecting Youth: The Role of Missouri Law Enforcement in Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention

Job Description: The Project Coordinator will script and oversee the production of a multi-media presentation to specifically address juvenile justice guidelines and recommended best practices for Missouri law enforcement. The presentation will spotlight best practices and guidelines for taking youth into custody as well as the purpose and use of the Juvenile Detention Assessment (JDTA), alternatives to detention outcomes and the Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative (JDAI).

Qualifications: Bachelor's Degree in criminal justice, psychology, sociology or related field is desired as well as three to five years of experience working in the Missouri Juvenile Justice System and working knowledge of Chapter 211 RSMo. Applicant must possess strong written and verbal communication skills, organizational skills and ability to work independently.
