

**The 43<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Circuit, Juvenile Office, is accepting applications for a position as a Juvenile Officer II.** An employee in this position is vested with the statutory authority of a juvenile court officer to take charge of children who come within the jurisdiction of the juvenile court. A Juvenile Officer II is expected to supervise juveniles under the court's jurisdiction and to work with a high degree of independence. This position requires knowledge of Missouri statutes, laws regarding juvenile cases, and juvenile courts and procedures. A Juvenile Officer II position also requires the ability to prepare motions, petitions, and other legal documents along with the ability to make recommendations to the juvenile court.

Candidates must have a bachelor's degree in behavioral or social science, i.e., social work, psychology, criminal justice, sociology, or a closely related field. Work experience can be substituted for a degree. Minimum requirement work experience is professional employment in a public or private agency involving substantial amount of time in the delivery of protective services to families, adults, children or the aged.
