- Referrals overall increased by 6.57%. The increases in referrals were seen primarily in the white youth group, with an increase of 5.38%, and the black youth group with an 8.88% increase. Of the 1276 new referrals in 2021, 454 of them were for black youth, comprising of 35.57% of the increase. Comparatively, black youth made up only 15% of the youth population for 2021.
- Detention increased 25.47%, Petitions increased 18.35%, Findings for Delinquency increased 16.52%, and Supervision increased 19.24%, and Secure Confinement to DYS increased 5.31%. While the overall adult transfer category showed a decrease of 9.09%, black youth actually showed an increase of 28.57% in adult certifications.

Note: Raise the Age legislation was implemented statewide in July 2021. Population and cases in 2020 are based on 10-16 year old juveniles. Population and cases in 2021 are based on 10-17 year olds.
