

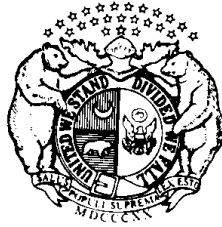

**Position:** Part-Time Detention Aide I/ Secure Detention Unit

**Description:** The Second Judicial Circuit Court, Juvenile Division is seeking applicants to fill the position of Part-Time Detention Aide I at the Bruce Normile Juvenile Justice Center, Kirksville, MO. Duties will include but not limited to the responsibility for safety, personal conduct, and care of juveniles. An employee in this position will be expected to work efficiently and with diverse populations. The position will be required to work 20 hours per week and be available to work varying hours during the week and weekend.

**Salary/Wages:** Annual salary of \$16,535.54. This position is regulated by Missouri State Court classification of Detention Aide I and all applicable state benefits will apply. This position is eligible for shift differential of \$2.00 per hour.
