- Referrals decreased by 1.6% overall. Referrals for White and Hispanic youth decreased by 3.0% and 16.8% respectively.
- Detention numbers increased by 7.2%, with White youth increasing 9.7% and Black youth increasing 4.2%. All other categories decreased from 2023 to 2024.
- There was a significant decrease of Black youth Petitions (-12.1%), Delinquency Findings (-16.0%), and Supervision (-22.6%).
